She stared at her reflection and started sculpting with clay, giving them a face, hands and feet. When the clay models hit the ground, they came alive. But it was too tiring sculpting them one by one, so she snapped off a vine and swung the clay around. Each splatter would become a human and soon the world became populated.	Giving players the option to use vines near clay to create small humans themselves.
Nu'Wa mending the sky	As above	An epic fight between deities broke the supporting beams connecting the ground and the sky. Giant holes appeared everywhere, volcanoes erupted, oceans flooded land. Nu'Wa melted stones of all colours and patched the holes, slashed off the feet of a giant turtle to replace a supporting beam.	Any 'epic' fights between giant creatures/humans may trigger a sky cracking event
Jing Wei filling the sea	Jing Wei – bird resembling a raven with a white beak and red claws	The ocean claimed the life of a young girl, and a bird emerged from its waters several day. It vowed to fill the ocean with rocks and twigs so it could never claim another life again.	Drowned humans becomes birds and start filling the sea?
Story of the sun	Three legged crows surrounded by golden beams.	There are ten crows. One flies up into the sky to act as the sun everyday and they take turn doing so.	-
Kua Fu chasing the sun	Kua Fu – giant human with snakes around his ears	Kua Fu is a tribal leader whose tribe is suffering tremendously from a great	Landscape? - peach blossom forest surrounded by prismatic clouds.

Hou Yi shooting the sun	Hou Yi - human	After the Kua Fu incident, the sun birds refused to be alone by themselves. Each day, all 10 of them would fly into the sky. Life became unbearable, so Hou Yi shot down 9 of the sun birds with his great bow. When he was about to shoot the final sun, he was stopped by the people as they needed one sun to survive.	If the sun bird population gets out of hand, newly formed humans will acquire bows and shoot them?
Story of Xing Tian	Xing Tian – headless giant whom grew eyes on his chest and mouth on his belly button. Wields giant axe and shield.	Giant Deity vowed for endless vengeance despite decapitation, through determination new eyes and mouth formed and he is thrown into constant and endless battle.	Grave hate for deities/humans, slashing around aimlessly until it sees humans, then tries to kill them all (adds uncertainty to player actions).
Zhu Yin	Zhu Yin – human face with red skin, one leg, body resembles that of a very long snake	Guardian of the arctics. When it opens its eyes it's summer and the sun shines, when it closes its eyes it becomes eternal darkness and winter. (explaining why arctics are bright only for half a year, and dark for another)	Player can interact to trigger day/night outside of the natural day/night cycle
