Context


This is my observation object, my pet named tony, a Thailand half moon betta.




Reflective

Context


For my context, this is Wat Sampran Dragon Temple in Bangkok. Huge and hit. I want to be a scene like that.

Context



The autumn sky corresponds to the afternoon and is a fiery cloud-like colour of warm oranges and reds. The winter sky corresponds to the evening with black and inky blue, a cold feeling. On t hese backgrounds, which represent the seasons, morning and evening, I have used flipclip to creat e some animations that represent the passage of time. On the summer background, the flowers are in full bloom. On the autumn background is the process of falling leaves. On the winter backgroun d is the moon in its cloudiness. Week8 Characters, environment and events


Context
